

How Your State or Organization Can Support the Cancer Moonshot National Initiative

Moonshot Goals

In the next 25 years, decrease cancer deaths by 50% and improve cancer care for all.

● Goal #1: Prevent Cancer

Share cancer screening resources (breast, colorectal, lung) as well as state tobacco quitline/cessation services and HPV vaccination resources to reach more low-income populations.

● Goal #3: Increase Cancer Equity¹

Establish or expand community-clinical linkages to increase access to health insurance coverage and utilization of cancer screening services.

● Goal #5: Improve Treatments against Deadly and Rare Cancers
Support National Cancer Institute initiatives to learn more about these cancers.

● Goal #2: Diagnose Cancer Early

Promote cancer screenings in blue-collar industry worksites or as part of community-clinical partnerships to reach more low-income employees and populations.

● Goal #4: Target Cancer Treatments Based on the Individual

Support and promote ongoing cancer research and data sharing initiatives. Promote access to genetic testing and counseling (breast cancer). Engage communities to increase access to clinical trials.

● Goal #6: Support Cancer Patients, Cancer Survivors, and Caregivers

Share resources to support people with cancer and reduce the risk of cancer recurrence among cancer survivors, and promote clinical trials.

● Goal #7: Learn From Cancer Survivors

Encourage cancer survivors to share their stories and their data in national programs.
